HORSE SHOW HISTORY

The Greenwich Horse Show celebrates its 100th anniversary this year. Although not a consecutive run, it is an impressive one.

Originally held in 1914 at Nutbourne Farm in Port Chester, one of the features, a tradition continued today, was a luncheon given under a large tent on the show grounds.

In 1921 the show moved to Yale Farms off John Street and then in 1925 to the Greenwich Polo Club Grounds, on Quaker Ridge in Greenwich. The show relocated briefly in 1948 to the Blind Brook Turf and Polo Club on Anderson Hill Road in Purchase, NY before returning to Quaker Ridge in 1950, for a few years, and then back to Blind Brook for the 38th running in 1954.

After a five year absence, the GRTA Greenwich Horse Show returned in 1960 and was held on the property of Mr. William Heron at Lower Cross Road and Lake Avenue. When the Heron family sold their property, the show was moved, in the late 1970's and once again in 2021, to Coker Farm in Bedford, thanks to the generosity of Judy Richter.

The Greenwich Horse Show arrived at its current location, bringing us full circle, in 1982 moving back to Greenwich through the generosity of the Milliken family and more recently, the present owners.
