

#### Children's/Adult Jumper Division

Open to riders of all ages. Option to jump 2 'or 2'6". Champion and Reserve for most points in classes 1-3. Separate ribbons for children and adults, if the number of entries is sufficient.

<u>Classes 1, 2, 3.</u> <u>Children's/Adult Jumper</u>: Judged on number of faults and time. Fence height option of 2' or 2'6.

#### Children's/Adult Equitation/Hunter Division

Option to jump 2' or 2'6". Champion and Reserve for most points in classes 4-6 and 7-9.

<u>Class 4, 5 Ch/Ad Equitation Over Fences</u>: Judged on rider's form and performance over fences. Fence height option of 2 'or 2'6.

<u>Class 6. Ch/Ad Equitation Flat</u>: Judged on rider's form and performance on the flat (walk/trot/canter).

<u>Class 7, 8 Ch/Ad Hunter Over Fences</u>: Judged on horse's manners and performance over fences. Fence height option of 2' or 2'6.

<u>Class 9. Ch/Ad Hunter Under Saddle</u>: Judged on horse's manners and performance on the flat (walk/trot/canter).

#### Class 10. Pairs Walk/Trot

<u>Class 11. Pairs Over Fences</u> Horses/Ponies to be ridden in tandem. Last fence is taken abreast. Fences 2'.

<u>**Class 12. Family Class</u>** Judged at the walk. Related members of a family ride together. Judged on riders' form and turnout, number of family members, and number of generations shown.</u>

#### **Children's/Adult Pleasure Division**

Champion and Reserve for most points in classes 13-15.

Classes 13, 14, 15. Ch/Ad Pleasure: Judged on manners & performance.

<u>**Class 16. Bloody Mary Class**</u>: Open to adults 21 and over. Walk, trot, canter, and jump. First prize to the rider with the fullest glass. No entry fee.

<u>**Class 17. Cola Classic:**</u> Open to riders under 21. Walk, trot, canter, and jump. First prize to the rider with the fullest glass. No entry fee.

<u>Class 18. Lucky Buck</u>: Open to all ages. Riders provide their own dollars under each knee. First place wins 100% of the receipts. No entry fee.

<u>Classes 23, 24. SS/LS Equitation Flat</u>: Judged on rider's form and performance on the flat. Walk/Trot and Walk/Trot/Canter

<u>Classes 25, 26. SS/LS Hunter Over Fences</u>: Judged on horse's manners and performance over fences. Fence height 18".

<u>Class 27. SS/LS Hunter U/S</u>: Judged on horse's manners and performance over fences. Walk/Trot/Canter

# Children's/Adult Walk/Trot/Canter (W/T/C) Division

Open to riders of all ages. Champion and Reserve for most points in classes 28-31. Separate ribbons for children and adults, if the number of entries is sufficient.

<u>Class 28, 29. W/T/C Equitation</u>: Judged on rider's form and performance on the flat.

<u>Class 30, 31. W/T/C Pleasure</u>: Judged on horse's manners and performance on the flat. May be asked to jump one jump, canter in a group.

Champion and Reserve for most points in classes 32-35.

<u>Class 32, 33. W/T Equitation</u>: Judged on rider form & performance. <u>Class 34, 35. W/T Pleasure</u>: Judged on horse's manners and performance. May be asked to halt and back. May be asked to trot over groundpoles.
