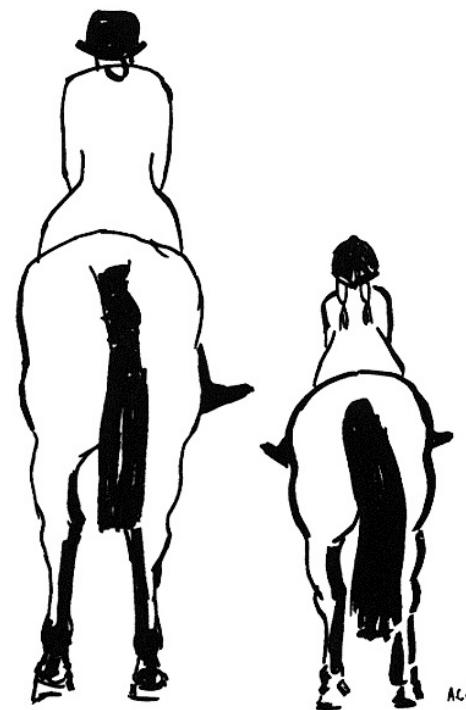

-A Day in the Country 2023 Class Descriptions-

Entry Fees: \$40 per class unless otherwise noted. \$50 secretary fee. \$20 red/blue schooling fee. Schooling in ring on flat only until 8:45am.

Start Time—9:00 am both rings

-RING 1-

Children's/Adult Jumper Division

Open to riders of all ages. Option to jump 2' or 2'6". Champion and Reserve for most points in classes 1-3. Separate ribbons for children and adults, if the number of entries is sufficient.

Classes 1, 2, 3. Children's/Adult Jumper: Judged on number of faults and time. Fence height option of 2' or 2'6".

Children's/Adult Equitation/Hunter Division

Option to jump 2' or 2'6". Champion and Reserve for most points in classes 4-6 and 7-9.

Class 4, 5 Ch/Ad Equitation Over Fences: Judged on rider's form and performance over fences. Fence height option of 2' or 2'6".

Class 6. Ch/Ad Equitation Flat: Judged on rider's form and performance on the flat (walk/trot/canter).

Class 7, 8 Ch/Ad Hunter Over Fences: Judged on horse's manners and performance over fences. Fence height option of 2' or 2'6".

Class 9. Ch/Ad Hunter Under Saddle: Judged on horse's manners and performance on the flat (walk/trot/canter).

Class 10. Pairs Walk/Trot

Class 11. Pairs Over Fences Horses/Ponies to be ridden in tandem. Last fence is taken abreast. Fences 2'.

Class 12. Family Class Judged at the walk. Related members of a family ride together. Judged on riders' form and turnout, number of family members, and number of generations shown.

Children's/Adult Pleasure Division

Champion and Reserve for most points in classes 13-15.

Classes 13, 14, 15. Ch/Ad Pleasure: Judged on manners & performance.

Class 16. Bloody Mary Class: Open to adults 21 and over. Walk, trot, canter, and jump. First prize to the rider with the fullest glass. No entry fee.

Class 17. Cola Classic: Open to riders under 21. Walk, trot, canter, and jump. First prize to the rider with the fullest glass. No entry fee.

Class 18. Lucky Buck: Open to all ages. Riders provide their own dollars under each knee. First place wins 100% of the receipts. No entry fee.

Class 19. (at noon): Children's Leadline: Walk only.

Class 20. (at noon): Parent Leadline

-RING 2-

Short Stirrup/Long Stirrup Equitation/Hunter Division

Open to riders of all ages. Fences 18". Champion and Reserve for most points in classes 21-24 and 25-27. Separate ribbons for children and adults, if the number of entries is sufficient.

Classes 21, 22. SS/LS Equitation Over Fences: Judged on rider's form and performance over 8 fence course. Fence height 18".

Classes 23, 24. SS/LS Equitation Flat: Judged on rider's form and performance on the flat. Walk/Trot and Walk/Trot/Canter

Classes 25, 26. SS/LS Hunter Over Fences: Judged on horse's manners and performance over fences. Fence height 18".

Class 27. SS/LS Hunter U/S: Judged on horse's manners and performance over fences. Walk/Trot/Canter

Children's/Adult Walk/Trot/Canter (W/T/C) Division

Open to riders of all ages. Champion and Reserve for most points in classes 28-31. Separate ribbons for children and adults, if the number of entries is sufficient.

Class 28, 29. W/T/C Equitation: Judged on rider's form and performance on the flat.

Class 30, 31. W/T/C Pleasure: Judged on horse's manners and performance on the flat. May be asked to jump one jump, canter in a group.

Walk/Trot Division

Champion and Reserve for most points in classes 32-35.

Class 32, 33. W/T Equitation: Judged on rider form & performance.

Class 34, 35. W/T Pleasure: Judged on horse's manners and performance. May be asked to halt and back. May be asked to trot over groundpoles.

Class 36. Costume Class: Open to all ages! Walk only. Individuals and groups encouraged.

-Classes may be split-
